



- 5. Garage (Converted to Offices in 1935; Winter Quarters 1971-1996)
- 6. Main Barn and Appendages
- 7. The Little Bull Barn (Manure Shed in 1918)
- Calf Shed, Creamery, Milking Barn and Calf Shed (1918-1932); Partly rebuilt 1932 as Laboratories.
- Former Radioisotope Laboratory, Shop and Storage (All built before 1931)
- 10. Manure Shed and Pit
- Brooder No. 2 (converted to single-family, employee cottage; later a camp infirmary 1971-1996)
- 12. Spring House
- 13. Hennery (converted to two-family employees' cottage before 1931)
- Brooder No. I (converted to employee cottage before 1931; Graduate Student Dormitory 1945-1970.)
- 15. Matthews House and detached two-car garage
- 16. Gardener's Storage House and Workshop
- 17. Small Fire House and Hydrant
